In order to promote student engagement and encourage students and young practitioners to enter into the field of international construction law, the ICLA has established and is pleased to announce the first annual ICLA Essay Competition in International and Comparative Construction Law.

REQUIREMENTS:

Submissions should not exceed 10,000 words and will be evaluated by a distinguished panel of judges from the international construction law industry.

The winner will receive € 1,500, an invitation to the next ICLA conference to present their paper and to take part in the conference (economy airfare and hotel accommodation to be provided by the ICLA), and a one-year membership to the ICLA.

In addition, the ICLA will assist the winning author in seeking to have their submission published in a leading academic journal.
