# Official Stuff You Can't Skip

All international students must register with the local police within 15 days - this is called E-FRRO registration.

You're IAGI (The Office of International Affairs & Global Initiatives) SPOC (Single Point of Contact) will guide you through the process - no worries! You'll get bonafide and residence proof; the rest you have to complete.

Miss the deadline? Fines may apply, so stay on top of it!



*Get involved in student clubs and events - it's the best way to feel at home.*


## Safety First!
