Required documents to be mailed: 1. Peking University Application Form for International Students (Visiting Student Programs). 2. Official Transcripts in English or Chinese. 3. A copy of the passport information page. 4. A Resume in English. 5. A Motivation Letter. 6. A Nomination Letter from the home institution. 7. Two Letters of Recommendation from professors at the home institution. * When filling up the form under item 1, please upload a passport-style and bareheaded photo. A passport copy, or casual snapshot shall not be accepted. ** Please glue the photo on the form when preparing a hardcopy for item 1. *** The passport under item 3 shall be an ordinary one. Diplomatic passport or other special types of passports shall not be accepted. You may have to apply for a new passport if the original one expires in 2026. **** For the nomination letter, please request your home institute to fill in the form (2026年春季学期北京大学法学院来访交换学生提名推荐表格/ Nomination for 2026 Spring Semester Exchange Program of PKU Law School).

Course Information	
Language of Instruction	Chinese & English

	For students want to enroll in English-taught courses, they ought to submit an English-language certificate (TOEFL 90 or IETLS 6.5) or provide a certificate of English proficiency from the sending university unless they are from an institution where the instruction language is English. Basic knowledge of Chinese language is recommended for all students studying in Beijing.

Course Package

In each semester, approximately 100 courses in Chinese and English would be offered by PKU Law School. Each credit generally equals 50 minutes of classes per week.

* The courses listed above will **NOT** be always available in every semester. At the beginning of each semester, students will be informed of courses available.

** We encourage students to enroll in the courses instructed in Chinese. It's a great chance to improve Chinese and get acquainted with more Chinese professors and

classmates.

*** **Students can ONLY choose courses offered by law school.** And each student can choose NO MORE than 4 courses a semester. There are no Chinese Language courses.

**** As required, **students from Singapore can only take courses taught in Chinese.**

Course Enrollment and Transcripts

Enrollment Process	Students will enroll in courses after registering at PKU. A separate instruction would be sent at the beginning of a semester regarding course enrollment.
Credit Cap	Students at PKU Law School can ONLY enroll in no more than 4 courses per semester.
Transcripts	The original copy of transcripts would generally be posted or emailed to students' home institution at the beginning of the Fall 2026 semester.

Visa

Incoming students must bring a valid passport and either a study visa ("X1") [for students studying for more than 6 months] or a visiting visa ("X2") [for students studying for less than 6 months]. The visa application form can be downloaded via <https://studyinchina.edu.cn/> after students receive their acceptance letter. Law School exchange students should apply the X2 visa to Chinese Embassy in their home country with the Acceptance Letter, visa application form and other materials as required by the Chinese Embassy. Other visa types will not be allowed to register at PKU.

* The visa falls within the mandates of Chinese diplomatic authority. **Any information related to visa application in this document can only be informative instead of legally binding. Please consult with the Embassy or Consulate in charge should you have any questions.**

Housing and Cost of Living

Housing Information	PKU Law School can NOT provide dormitory for incoming students. Students are advised to rent a house in the market.
Cost of Living	Housing (and utilities): RMB 15000 Food and Miscellaneous: RMB 11000 Books: RMB 200 Local transportation: RMB 500-1000 * The cost of living is estimated based on previous experience to live for a semester. The figure may be subject to change on a case-by-case basis.

Activities

Orientation	Incoming students are required to register on designated time and attend the orientation held by PKU International Students Division. For more information, please check the handbook for exchange students. More orientation(s) may be held by PKU Law School for local student who want to study abroad. All incoming students are encouraged to join that event to discuss with Chinese students.
Student Buddies	Every incoming student may be assigned with 1 or 2 student buddies who would help them with issues of studying at Peking University.

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
